We also have Quarry Park (while technically not in HMB) which is an amazing place to walk dogs both on leash and off.

### **3. Do you support allowing dog walking access on some Coastside beaches and trails? If yes, which beaches and trails do you believe should allow off-leash (under voice control) dog walking and which should allow only on-leash dog walking?**

100% I support dog walking on beaches. I am working right now on getting legal off leash dog walking on Poplar Beach Southward. Poplar beach northward would be dogs on leash only. Both would allow dogs, but I am advocating for legal off leash areas for dogs under voice control. I also am advocating for this at Surfers beach – which currently allows dogs on leash, but not technically off leash.

### **4. Is there anything else you would like voters to know about your position on recreational dog walking access?**

I am a full believer in off leash dogs. All my dogs, Aussie and Border Collie mixes from Doggie Protective Services, have been taught to be under voice control. They all love to run, and it is very important to me to find legal ways to do it.
